

NRHS Performing Arts Trip 2022 Overview (9th-12th grade)

Tuesday, April 26 through Sunday, May 1, 2022

- Meet at NRHS Tuesday after school. Board a school bus to the Boston Logan Airport and fly to Orlando
- Take the bus to Walt Disney World Pop Century (or something similar), check in.
- Stay on Disney property through Sunday with free access to their public transportation & the hotel pool
- While at Disney we will...
 - o 4 day ticket with access to all four parks (Magic Kingdom, Epcot, MGM, Animal Kingdom)
 - o Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included each day (except travel days when food will need to be purchased at the airport – on their own)
 - o All students will be separated by Classes:
 - Concert Band, Jazz Band and Marching Band will perform, be adjudicated and take a master class
 - NOTEorious and Chorus will perform, be adjudicated and take a master class
 - All other students will participate in a technical master class and have work assessed by Disney professionals
- Flight home Sunday

Estimated total cost for this trip is estimated to be \$1,800.00

To hold your spot, a non-refundable deposit of \$300. Space is limited due to airline tickets

Second non-refundable installment of \$300 is due **Friday, Sept. 24, 2021.**

Third non-refundable installment of \$300 is due **Friday, November 19, 2021**

Forth non-refundable installment of \$300 is due **Friday, January 28, 2022**

Fifth non-refundable installment of \$300 is due **Friday, March 18, 2022**

Last non-refundable installment of \$300 (or remainder) is due **Tuesday, April 12, 2022**
at the 7:00pm **mandatory** parent and student meeting in the HS Performing Arts Center
