Notes about Disney in April 2022

April Weather: The temperature will start to get up there towards the end of April, with highs in the upper 80s. Lows are usually in the upper 60s. The average high is 87 and the average low is 63. Historically, late April is relatively dry.

Port Orleans Riverside

How do I get into my room? Walt Disney World will give us room keys that you can upload to your magic band if you want. We are not providing magic bands.

Are there hairdryers in the room? Hairdryers are included in each room.

What are the room temperature controls like? Each room can be set to your desired temperature. Look for a small monitor on the wall (normally next to the window) and press the up or down arrow to increase or decrease desired temperature settings. You can set the temperature down in the 50s, but it never really gets that cold.

Are there safes in the rooms? Yes, every room at the has a key operated safe. The safe is small. Larger safekeeping boxes are available at the Front Desk. You will be charged a fee if you lose the safe key, so be careful.

Are refillable mugs available? Yes, Refillable Mugs are available at the food court, and allow unlimited refills at the dinging court during your stay. Mugs can be refilled with the following items: Coke, Diet Coke, Caffeine Free Diet Coke, Cherry Coke, Barq's Root Beer, Sprite, Minute Maid Pink Lemonade, Minute Maid Orange Soda, Nestea Unsweetened Iced Tea, Nescafe coffee, Nescafe decaf coffee, water (hot or cold), hot chocolate, and assorted hot tea. Fruit juices and milk are not available for refills. You can take the mug with you to the park as well. You would have to pay for your own approx \$25 tax and fees included.

DINING SUGGESTIONS

On your map or the app, locate the counter service restaurants with one dollar sign. They will have the platters that Disney suggested we use for lunch and dinner. Meals will be approx. \$15. If you want more, be cautious to spend your money wisely so you don't run out. Keep all receipts with you.

If you want a sit down meal, you need to call NOW for reservations. Large groups are difficult to seat. Be flexible with your times. Maybe eat at non-traditional times. For example, you'll have a better chance at 1:30 lunch reservations than 11:30 or noon.

You will need a credit card to put the reservation on. If you cancel within 48 hours or don't show at all, a minimum of \$10 will be placed on the credit card per person. The fee could be higher!

Make lunch your biggest meal of the day. Prices are less but the most of the portions are the same. Then pocket a bagel or bread roll for a snack later on. Keep costs down and you could get by with just a snack or two. Remember, even snacks are very expensive. For example: a bag of chips is \$4.99. An ice cream can be \$7-8. Water is always free.
